


FRYUP

The origin of the name Fryup is most likely to stem from a combination of the name of the Old Norse goddess of love, Freyja, and hop, which denotes a small valley. In Norse mythology, Freyja is a goddess associated with love, beauty, fertility, gold, sorcery, war, and death.

KOLA

Kola Kubes was a glamour model, actress, singer, competitive eater, professional wrestler, restauranteur, author, director, documentary maker and artist from Fryup. She starred in the seminal 1994 pornographic film *Sweet Tooth*, which earned her four adult XVN awards, and ranked as one of Playboy's Top 100 Sex Stars of the Century. She was married seven times and had three children. She died in August 2009 in Fryup of a combined drug intoxication.


A shapely young scientist (Kola Kubes) is dispatched to her home village of Fryup to investigate a reported outbreak of nymphomania that is afflicting the local community, causing crops to remain unharvested and the local economy to teeter on the brink of collapse. She must do whatever it takes to uncover the truth before it is too late.



PUNK PIRATES

Punk Pirates were a punk rock band from Fryup. Their debut single, We Are Punk Pirates, reached number ten in the UK charts in October 1985, despite being widely denied radio airplay. Their debut album, We are Punk Pirates - Now Fuck Off! made number twenty despite also being withdrawn from sale in many record shops. The band split up following the disappearance and presumed suicide of lead singer Johnny Pitcairn in December 1986.

Sierra Leone was a dancer in the Punk Pirates. Leone caused controversy by appearing naked on the original cover of the band's first album, *We are Punk Pirates - Now Fuck Off!* at the age of sixteen. Leone sported a series of bizarre and risqué outfits on stage, including being body-painted as a smurf, and wearing a ballgown made entirely from see-through bubble-wrap, which she invited audience members to pop. The band's 1986 US tour was curtailed two minutes into the opening gig at the Four Queens casino in Las Vegas, when Leone defied prior warnings by appearing on stage covered only in whipped cream. Federal agents invaded the stage and arrested Leone for gross indecency; the remaining band members were also detained for inciting a subsequent riot that left ten people hospitalized. Charges were dropped in return for the band immediately leaving the country.





KOLABURGER

The first Kolaburger restaurants were launched simultaneously in 2004 in Fryup and the New Frontier hotel in Las Vegas. Mixing beef patties with confectionary, menu choices included the *Kolaburger* (two beef patties, pickles, cheese, kola kubes); the *Candyburger* (two beef patties, pickles, candyfloss); the *Hawaiian* (two beef patties, pickles, cheese, pineapple chunks); and the *Loveburger* (two beef patties, pickles, cheese, love hearts). In 2007, Kolaburger released a series of limited edition celebrity-inspired burgers including the *Anna Nicole Burger* (two battered chicken patties, Godiva chocolates); the *Ghostface Killahburger* (two battered fish patties, ravioli, French vanilla ice cream, buttered pecan ice cream, caramel sundae) and the *Elvis Trilogy Burger* (three fried banana and peanut butter sandwiches in a bun). Health campaigners called Kolaburger a "calorie calamity".

TANYA

Tanya Lasagne is a conceptual and performance artist whose work explores nostalgia, identity and the paradoxes of parochialism. She won the Waterhouse Prize in 2002 for *The Tide Is High*, an empty room in which twenty kippers were secreted behind the walls and beneath the floorboards, contriving a work that was entirely olfactory. For a performance piece in the grounds of the London's Streatham Gallery in 2010, she created the world's biggest lasagne, weighing 4,000 kg and comprising 1,500kg of pasta sheets. In 2012, Lasagne exhibited a four-hour film of herself having a fox-and-hounds tattoo inked onto her buttocks and lower back. The tattoo featured a pack of hounds chasing a fox, visible only by the tail disappearing into her anus.

PEARL

Pearl Siskin was a sixteen year old girl who disappeared during an outward bound weekend at the Tripsdale Outdoor Centre in May 1992. Despite extensive searches and a number of reported sightings, she has never been found.

Siskin studied survivalist techniques from a young age, confounding acquaintances with her knowledge of local flora and fauna, and often fantasised to friends about living undetected in the wild.

One of Siskin's class teachers, Pamela Brayshaw, was questioned at length about her disappearance, after it was claimed that Siskin had threatened to reveal details of Brayshaw's affair with a fellow pupil. Brayshaw was absolved of any part in Siskin's disappearance, but was forced to resign her position. Brayshaw later posed for a series of explicit photographs in a top-shelf magazine wearing a gown and mortar board, and published a book, *The Tripsdale Incident*, in which she claimed "incontrovertible proof" that Siskin had been abducted by aliens.

FLYWEIGHT

Roscoe Siskin (born October 29, 1974) is a former professional boxer from Fryup who competed from October 1993 to August 2002. He held the undisputed world flyweight title from April 1998 to May 1999 and was voted the forty-sixth greatest puncher of all time by *The Ring* magazine. He was twice married to the adult movie actress Kola Kubes. He has five known children, Rocky Siskin and Olga Molotov-Siskin (1989, with Nadia Molotov), Treasure Siskin (1999, with Honey Coombs), Roscoe Siskin Jr. (2001, with Kola Kubes), and Roxette Siskin (2001, with Samantha Roxby). Another son, Rocco Siskin (1998, with Goldie Starr) was killed in a gang fight in Juarez, Mexico in 2015. After retiring from boxing, Siskin established a pigeon loft at his home on the edge of the Fryup moors and won a number of national competitions with birds named after former world flyweight champions, including Skinny Montana, winner of the prestigious 2005 Barcelona International.

FRACULA

Fracula arrives in Whitby but his route towards London grinds to a halt in notoriously inaccessible Fryupdale, where he finds the locals' blood, distilled by generations of inbreeding, distinctly to his liking. With the help of a pair of besotted local vamp fans, Fracula duly lands a job as scarer-in-residence at the local Dracula Experience and sets about feeding his insatiable appetite in the middle of the moors.





FLF

The Fryup Liberation Front (FLF) was the name given to a group that claimed responsibility for a series of incidents in Fryup between 1985 and 1994, including vandalism, arson and kidnapping, purportedly in response to the Thorsby Estate's application for a compulsory purchase order of an area of land known locally as 'The Statics', a former holiday park now used as a caravan site for long-term residents.

On August 20, 1995, a Kwik Save van was hijacked on the road to Fryup Hall by a group of individuals wearing balaclavas and waving weapons. The van's driver, John Wood, was ordered out of the vehicle, whereupon its contents were emptied and the van pushed down a nearby ravine. By now the case made national headlines, and a manifesto issued by the FLF appeared in the local Gazette.

April Sprule (April 9 1972 - May 9 2020) was a convicted murderer and suspected serial killer. In 1997, Sprule admitted killing Clint Thackeray. She served 20 years in prison before being released on licence in 2020. She is the elder sister Tina Sprule and Tammy Sprule, better known by their respective *noms-de-guerre*, Kola Kubes and Tanya Lasagne.

FCW

Fryup Championship Wrestling (FCW) was a wrestling promotion and media company based in Fryup. Its roster included high-flying local favourite and three-time champion Clint Lightnin', 6ft 8ins Ivan The Terrible (who often teamed in tag contests with 4ft 10ins Midget Gem), undefeated women's tag-team champions The Camo Girls, and 32-stone Ken Tucky, a southern American hick who waded to the ring tossing pieces of fried chicken into the crowd from a family-In August 2000, FCW staged the 'Kandy Klash' sized bucket. between reigning women's champion Honey Coombs and former adult movie star Kola Kubes at the Fryup Showgrounds in a match broadcast live on the XVN pay-per-view network. combatants wore lingerie and brawled in pools of whipped cream, jell-O and hundreds-and-thousands that had been placed around ringside. In a scripted finale, Kubes was awarded victory when The Camo Girls entered the arena and performed their trademark 'AK' move on Coombs whilst Kubes distracted the referee by performing a striptease.

TITS

Flocks of Fryup tits swoop down and strip a bush of sea buckthorn in a matter of seconds. They zip through shrubs and gardens like raucous gangs of marauding pirates, snatching up everything in sight. So numerous are the scarlet-breasted Fryup tits it has been said they render their region in a perpetual state of sunrise. Yet it is a curious trait of the Fryup tit that it is never seen to stray beyond the historic boundaries of the parish. It is often observed perching on fences at parish limits, refusing to flit to buckthorn bushes a matter of yards away.

PURPLE WAVE

The unlikely rising stars of *Purple Wave* were photographed for an infamous 1982 *Face magazine* spread, under the heading: *INBREDS: The Not-So-Secret Face of Feral Britain*. Levi Presley, whom the directors claimed to have plucked from an abandoned moorland hill-farm where he had been leading a semi-wild existence for the best part of a decade, poses precariously atop a rusted old combine wearing just a pair of filthy track shorts. Presley's girlfriend, Heather Moreland, pokes the embers of a campfire in a Minnie Mouse tee-shirt. Two flame-haired identical twins huddle close by, clasping their bare knees and gazing glaze-eyed at the sky. A clown-faced midget curls asleep inside an old truck tyre. A line of dead moles are pinned by their tails to a barbed-wire fence.

BILBERRIES

It was always said you could tell when you were eating a bilberry picked by a Siskin, because they knew the secret spots where the fruits grew sweeter and more juicy. As a result, the Siskins' bilberries were in high demand. Keen to muscle in on the Siskins' venture, the Sprules, many of whom were labourers working on the Thorsby estate, convinced the landowners to invoke inclosures legislation in order purge the Siskins, a band of itinerant hawkers who had roamed the high moors for generations. Bands of toughs led by Sprule boys were dispatched to the moors to threaten and intimidate the Siskins into retreat. The subsequent confrontations became known as the Tripsdale Bilberry Wars, and began a feud between the two families that continues to this day.



TANYA II

Lasagne presented *Deathcap Lasagne* at the Streatham Gallery in 2008, comprising a plate of lasagne made using deadly deathcap mushrooms. In place of a menu, a laminated sheet listed the devastating effects of eating the mushrooms. The work was re-made every five days for the duration of the exhibition. Lasagne said: "I would head out into the countryside, literally searching for death."

LARKS

The pitch-black St Mark's Lark, also known as the Witch-Lark and the Ghost-Lark, resides deep in the notorious moorland Coal Holes and is rarely seen. It is said if one is witnessed on St Mark's Eve, that person is doomed to die within the next 12 months. Others believe each St Mark's Lark is a manifestation of a particular witch that has died in the community, and escaped her coffin. The St Mark's Lark builds its nest out of twigs from the rowan or mountain-ash tree, which is traditionally known as 'witch-wood'.

TREASURE

Eighteen years old and nine-stones-nothing, Treasure Siskin reigns as the undisputed queen of competitive eating. A three-time, undefeated winner of the FFC Jamboree, the "Fryup Phenom" shattered her own world record by downing four fried chicken buckets with sides and sauces in just twelve minutes: that's more than one pound per minute, and a heart-stopping six thousand calories. She also won the notorious FFC Friggin' Hot Chicken Chilli Challenge, then swept the board by sinking 10lbs of FFC Badass Bilberry Pie to become the first ever triple-challenge champ at the famous festival. "I guess we're all good at something," says Treasure, a devout Christian who refuses to compete on Sundays and scrawls blessings on buckets at £10 a pop. "I truly believe my talent is a gift from God."

FFC

Folk travel from miles around to feast on Fryup Fried Chicken, labouring for hours over desolate moors and through steep ravines. A handful of hardy locals perch at picnic tables and chomp greedily through the solitary menu item, buckets of crispy golden thighs, as tomorrow's dinner pecks around their feet. It is a little greasy, and the meat is tough. But the effect is something indefinable: soon after the first bite your lips start to tingle, and you are enveloped by a feeling of mild euphoria. They say the secret lies in the chicken feed, which incorporates a rare local mushroom, the blushing morel, that is deadly if eaten directly. Locals call it" Fryup fugu". Madonna is said to have once paid a secret visit; Anthony Bourdain was forced to turn back due to landslides. The two elderly brothers who own the tiny tumbledown shack that visitors insist serve up the best fried chicken on the planet, steadfastly refuse to give up their secrets.






KILLER BEES

Fryup Killer Bees (FKB) was a hip-hop collective from Fryup, North Yorkshire. Its original members were Freya The Slayer, Clint The Wise Man, MC Sadie, and the fictional F-Boy. FKB self-released its eponymous debut mixtape in 2008, as well as various solo and collaborative projects over the subsequent years, often using a variety of pseudonyms. In 2010, it released its second mixtape, *Revenge of the Killer Bees*. In 2011, Freya The Slayer released her solo concept album, *Further Adventures*, which was described by Spin Magazine as "excitingly disruptive". Clint's *W£TCH4UCKIN* was released in the same year. FKB announced its disbandment in 2013. Pitchfork wrote that FKB's legacy was "one that demands we bask in complicated truths, reminding us that nurturing the parts that don't fit is how any culture moves forward."

FRYUPS

The Fryup Islands, known colloquially as the 'Fryups', are a group of small islands situated between eight and ten miles off the North Riding coast. The largest islands in the group, Mardoll, Throng and Vanadis, were permanently inhabited from the Late Middle Ages until the early 19th century. Their population, never more than two hundred in number, originally lived in burrows and subsisted predominantly on seabirds and seals. They spoke Fryoese, a derivation of Old Norse and English. The outlying islands of St Agnes and St Olaf were populated by hermits in the 14th and 15th centuries. Hundreds of ships have been wrecked on the dangerous reefs that ring the islands, and the iconic, purple-striped Edda Lighthouse was completed in 1760. Since the beginning of the 20th century the islands have been temporarily inhabited and claimed, respectively, by Maoists, nudists, environmentalists, Bitcoin entrepreneurs and members of an End Times cult. The islands are popular with bird watchers, and are the only recorded nesting site of the critically endangered Dwarf Auk.





FRYUPS II

The Isaians were an apocalyptic cult whose beliefs were based on a literal interpretation of the Book of Isaiah. They believed that Isaiah had prophesied that the impending apocalypse would begin on remote islands, and that those who inhabited them, enduring their privations, would form the vanguard in the battle to establish Heaven on Earth. A group of twenty adults and ten children inhabited the outermost Fryup Island, St Olaf, for sixty days in 1998. The testimonies of a small group of Isaians who managed to escape convinced authorities to raid the island, where they found six cult members, including the group's leader, Solomon Sprule, dead by gunshot wounds or poisoning.



FRYUPS III

The Fryup island of Alviss is home to the last remaining colony of dwarf auks, sparrow-sized cousins of the similarly flightless great auk, which became extinct in the mid-19th century. Around fifty nesting pairs inhabit small caves at the foot of the island's virtually inaccessible sea-cliffs, creating a unique natural barrier against predation. Deptford warblers, so named for their habit of congregating around the wreck of the Deptford coal barge at low tide, are prevalent at the northern tip of Mardoll. Because of their association with shipwrecks, it is said that if a sailor encounters a Deptford warbler, he must skip and sing a shanty before he sets sail. The Fryup islands boast the only recorded British sightings of a number of species, including the Abyssinian scimitarbill, the pearly-eyed thrasher, and the fearful owl.

FRYUPS IV

Films shot all or partly on the Fryup islands include *Crazy Dwarf Time* (2002), a Blair Witch-style story of four teenage film-makers who set sail for the island of Alviss to explore its reputation for dwarf folklore. *Crazy Dwarf Time* won the "Golden Owl' for best film at the 2002 Tirana Film Festival. In 2006, Madonna reputedly alighted upon the islands to scope their potential as the location for a prospective sequel to her much-derided 2002 shipwreck saga *Swept Away*, but was dissuaded by persistent storms.

FRYUPS V

In his definitive study of life on the islands, *With the Fryoese* (1922), Gilbert Thorsby recalled one of the last permanent inhabitants, Idunn mar Sjoren, whom it was claimed lived to over one hundred years old without leaving her birthplace of Mardoll. mar Sjoren, whose surname literally translates as 'siren of the gulls' in Fryoese, wore a cloak made from hundreds of kittiwake beaks. Unlike other later Fryoese, who built their homes from wood and other materials salvaged from shipwrecks, mar Sjoren continued to live in a traditional Fryoese *hella*, or cave dwelling, until her death in 1910. Said to have been so beautiful in her day that she would stand on the rocks and lure ships to wreck, mar Sjoren was also widely believed to possess powers to summon storms and bestow curses upon those who betrayed her.



NKC

NKC, short for "No Knickers Club", was a feminist-anarchist group that originated at Fryup High School in the late 1980s. Inspired by Valerie Solanas' "SCUM Manifesto", its members, led by April Sprule, espoused the eradication of men, and performed a series of stunts aimed at humiliating those suspected of what they called "the perpetuation of the patriarchy". Initial tactics included honey-traps and the disruption of school events using fire extinguishers and stink-bombs; they swiftly evolved into incidents of kidnap, arson, and ultimately murder.



TANYA III

In 2012 Lasagne opened the Fryup Institute of Contemporary Art (FICA) with her show *Luminosity*, featuring paraphernalia from the semi-fictional Fryup Liberation Front (FLF). At the preview, Lasagne had the audience 'kidnapped' by a masked and apparently armed female gang who led them into Fryup forest, where they were kept in tents overnight, before being released early the next morning. The event, which referenced Graciela Carnevale's notorious Happening in Rosario in 1968, sparked a police investigation and a number of legal challenges from reluctant 'captives'.

MULLET FUCKERS

Mullet Fuckers follows a gang of degenerate teenagers who spend their days and nights roaming rural landscapes and semi-derelict farmsteads, filming one another on a VHS camera as they vandalise property, befriend eccentric locals - including the feral 'Mullet Boy' - and indulge in orgies. Adhering loosely to the principles of the Dogme 95 movement, Mullet Fuckers is presented as shot, in glitchy, black-and-white analogue format, and its dialogue is sporadic and often incoherent. It was described as "perversely beautiful" and "grubbily transgressive" by Film Magazine, and won a Silver Apricot at the 2010 Yerevan International Film Festival.

KICK-START

Duke Thorsby finished second on Junior Kick-Start. He had gelled-up hair and a dangly ear-ring, and a girlfriend called Frog Eyes who gave him blowjobs. He got killed by a gypo curse. Gypo curses kill you unless you cross their palms with silver, or if you get a mirror and reflect the curse back onto the gypos. It picked him up and chucked him off the edge of the quarry. It spewed his brains and splattered him out like a stamped-on slug.



TANYA IV

From September 26, 2014 to September 26, 2015, Lasagne embarked upon a one-year performance piece during which she remained within the parish boundary of Fryup and refrained from entering any otherwise inhabited dwelling. Initially equipped only with a sleeping bag, spare clothes and a small video camera, Lasagne subsisted by foraging, stealing and begging, and sought shelter in caves and derelict farm buildings. She was shot at during an attempt to poach trout, incurring an injury which required a two-day break in the project for hospital treatment. Lasagne's footage was subsequently manifested in a five-hour movie, *Nine Million Rainy Days*, that premiered at the 2017 Naples Biennale. Lasagne said the project was inspired by a childhood fascination with vagrants whom she would occasionally encounter in country lanes.

FRYUPX

FryupX formed a regular stage of the British Motocross Championship until it was removed from the calendar in 1984 following the deaths of two competitors. The race, staged in Fryup quarry and notorious for features including Hell Ridge and Dead Man's Drop, continued in unregulated form, attracting huge crowds. Multiple winners include local riders Duke Thorsby, who was killed in the event in 1990, and Kirk Sykes. Sykes courted tabloid attention in 1996 as the boyfriend of the adult movie star Kola Kubes, who revealed that Sykes always raced naked beneath his bike leathers.





ZSA ZSA

Zsa Zsa Siskin was the first and only female winner of the notorious FryupX motocross race in 1996. Blonde-haired and blue-eyed, Siskin's win caused a sensation and led to offers of photo-shoots and celebrity appearances. Siskin - her father claimed her first name was "the closest I could summon to the sound of a 125cc engine growling into life" - rejected them all and committed to retaining her title. In the same race the following year, Siskin was involved in a controversial incident involving her rival, Kirk Sykes, that caused her to crash out and break her back. Siskin required several major operations was told she would never ride again. Siskin returned to the race in 2000, finishing 10th. She became a professional stunt rider, acting as a double in major films, and was the first person to jump over Fryup Ridge in 2001.



FROG EYES

Frog Eyes was called Frog Eyes because she had big, buggy-out eyes. No-one called her Frog Eyes to her face because she was a black belt in karate. She swivel-kicked you in the head if you tried to feel her up. She could slice right through a pile of bricks with a single chop. She could balance one-legged on a barbed-wire fence. She could crack a nut with her butt-cheeks. Sometimes we shouted "wax on.. wax off" at her, like out of Karate Kid, then ran like hell.

TANYA V

In 2018, Lasagne committed to submitting an entry in every class of the produce and horticulture sections at Fryup Show: a total of 112 classes comprising vegetables, flowers, floral art, eggs, preserves and honey, home baking, handicrafts, painting and photography. She acquired a large allotment and kept hens and bees. Sprule won thirty-eight prizes, including ten first places, £67 in prize money (a profit of £11 after entry fees), and two trophies, for most points in the home baking section, and best chutney. She failed to submit entries for six classes. Lasagne chronicled her project in a diary and a short film, 'Show Saturday'. The Guardian called Sprule's work "the ultimate guerrilla exhibition".



SUPER SIX

The Super Six is a series of young adult adventure novels written by Sprule devised the stories as an antidote to Enid Ingrid Sprule. Blyton's Famous Five, declaring: "The teenagers I know do not spend their days conjuring wholesome escapades over cucumber sandwiches: they swear, lust, steal and lose interest." Sprule wrote scores of Super Six novels, claiming to complete them at a rate of more than one per week, and many of her manuscripts remained unpublished. Recurring characters included the head-strong Dolores (also known as Goldie), the broodingly mysterious Caleb, semi-feral Levi, tomboy Delia, Gem, a midget, and Gem's pet polecat, Dot. Plots involved rape, incest, pregnancy and abortion, murder, arson, kidnap, torture, robbery, sado-masochism, slavery and sheep-They were often left unresolved, and seldom made reference to previous escapades; Delia, for example, dies on at least a dozen occasions. While most of the early stories were set in semifictional Fryupdale, later adventures sent the Super Six around the world, stranding them on a desert island in Six Survive a Plane Wreck, and even into space in the sci-fi sub-series Six Trek, in which they were beamed up by aliens and taken to a distant planet.

TOUCAN

The moor toucan is a descendent of a pair of toco toucans that escaped from a North Yorkshire zoo in the late 19th century. Remarkably, it found the moorland's dense ravines to its liking, to the extent that it successfully bred and adopted enough unique characteristics - including an unmistakable scarlet streak on the underside of its bill - to acquire its own sub-species (*Ramphastos maurus*). Beyond neotropical areas of Central and South America, Fryup remains the only place in which toucans have successfully bred.

PURPLE WAVE II

NAKED VIRGIN MANHUNT (2000)

The unexplained arrival of a nameless and seemingly deaf-mute Japanese girl in a remote backwoods community in the North Riding wreaks havoc, stirring discriminatory forces and rekindling old superstitions that compel the residents reach a gruesome conclusion. Cue an eighty-minute thrill ride to the terrifying heart of the thickly surrounding forest, as the object of the locals' lurid attention takes increasingly desperate measures to resist her pursuers before her shocking secret is finally revealed.

RODEO

Lacy-Wayne Siskin started out riding sheep on the family farm in Fryup at the age of six. Waylon, her rodeo-fan father, soon had her graduating to unbroken colts, before marking her tenth birthday by sitting her on Buck, their 1,500lb Friesian bull, for the first time. "I had him on a short leash but no sooner had Lacy-Wayne perched her tiny behind on his back than he had snapped free and was off, high-kicking and whaling it across the yard," said Waylon. "She clung on for a good few seconds till he flipped her so high I figured on her coming back down with snow in her hair." Lacy-Wayne had the good fortune to career head-first into a nearby haystack, from which she emerged beaming and unscathed, but for a black eye and a few bruised ribs. "That's when I knew she had what it took,' continued Waylon, who has sold off his stock and is preparing to head off to the US next season in the hope of winning her a place on the PBR Mini Bull-Riders' Tour.

FRINDALOO

To mark the opening of Fryup's first Indian restaurant, the Fryup Mahal, in 2012, its chefs created the 'Frindaloo' - dubbed the world's hottest curry after tipping the scales at a scorching six million Scoville units. Trying the curry - made with a locally-developed chilli called the Killer Bee - became such a rite of passage among locals that it has remained on the menu. Chefs prepare it wearing goggles and surgical masks, and each order must come with a signed disclaimer. Winners get their money back, plus a certificate and a tee-shirt. In 2015, the 'Frindaloo' featured in a special international episode of the Food Network's 'Man v. Food': food won. In fact, so far only one diner, the teenage competitive eating champion Treasure Siskin, has managed it: she woofed her 'Frindaloo' down in fifteen minutes before coolly requesting a bowl of ice cream.



FRYDOC

FryDoc, the Fryup Documentary Film Festival, awards its annual Purple Pistol for the best short documentary made within, or inspired by, the parish boundaries. Fryup: where truth is stranger than fiction.

Shortlist:

...NOW FUCK OFF: Uses interviews and found footage to tell the story of the ill-fated US tour by Fryup band the Punk Pirates, which lasted just two minutes before they were arrested and deported. (60 mins)

TRUE BLUE: Follows a day in the life of a Fryup woman who has spent the last two decades going about her business whilst painted and dressed as a smurf (30 mins)

LITTLE KINGDOM: A group of midgets set sail for the remote Fryup island of Alviss, with an ambitious plan to proclaim it the world's first Diminutive Republic. (60 mins)

FIRE IN YOUR EYES: Charts attempts by locals and visitors alike to conquer the world's hottest curry, the Frindaloo, at the Fryup Mahal. (24 mins)

FINDING LEVI: As curators prepare the first exhibition of his work, *Finding Levi* recounts the life of Levi Presley, who left behind hundreds of Polaroids and unprocessed negatives of his friends' escapades in the Fryup forest when he died in 1996 at the age of just twenty-two. (58 mins)

TANYA VI

For "Being and Nothingness" (FICA, 2015), Lasagne filled three rooms with, respectively, whipped cream, custard and Jell-O. A fourth room contained a *Crackerjack*-style "gunge tank", which activated at random intervals throughout the day; beneath it was a stool upon which visitors were invited to sit. Exhibition notes comprised Jean-Paul Sartre's eponymous 1943 essay, in which he wrote: "Slime is the revenge of the in-itself. A sickly-sweet, feminine revenge.. a sugary-sliminess is the ideal of the slimy; it symbolizes the sugary death of the For-itself (like that of the wasp which sinks into the jam and drowns in it"

FRUNK

This is a list of *notable Frunk bands*. Frunk is a sub-genre of hardcore punk rock generally identified by its aggressive lyrics and extreme brevity - songs seldom lasted longer than 90 seconds - that was popularised in Fryup in the late 1980s.

BURGLARS

Fryup Burglars were a short-lived motorcycle speedway team who were established in 1996 and won the National Alliance and KO Cup in their inaugural season. The team collapsed on the cusp of their debut in the National League following the death of star rider Shawn Sprule, who was shot dead by team owner Dirk Thorsby on suspicion of an affair with his Polish wife Roxana, who was also killed. Thorsby was sentenced to life in prison for the murders. The Fryup Raceway remained derelict for a number of years but subsequently reopened for stock car racing as the Kwik Save Oval.

GAGA

For the MTV Video Music Awards in 2010, Lady Gaga wore a dress made entirely of Fryup Fried Chicken wrappers. "It's certainly no disrespect to anyone who's vegan or vegetarian," she explained. "I'm the most judgement-free human being on the Earth. It has many interpretations, but for me it's saying that we must all stand up for what we believe in; that we are our own sanctuary; that we all have wings."

BANDIT

Famed for its depraved human sheep-shearing parties, in which nude models were covered in whipped cream and contestants encouraged to 'shear' them using only their tongues, and its deafening blend of local anarcho-punk and hardcore house, The Bandit was a short-lived Fryup gay club so notorious it was forced to keep its exact location secret, and whisk blindfolded revellers to its door down rutted farm tracks. A-List stars begged for an invite: Madonna slopped up midway through her Blond Ambition world tour and took to the stage in a pair of wellies and her iconic conical corset, clutching a bucket of Fryup Fried Chicken.



COLD BLOW

Cold Blow was a notorious detention facility housing some of the country's most violent young female prisoners in the midst of the bleak Fryup moors. Regularly exposed in the media for its Victorianera facilities and sadistic staff, Cold Blow hit the headlines again in 1996 when three inmates led by Yvonne Sprule staged the first and only successful escape by hijacking a food delivery truck during a pre-planned riot. Two of the escapees were apprehended within forty-eight hours but Sprule has never been found. The incident inspired the 1999 Purple Wave movie *Escape From Cold Blow*. Cold Blow was permanently closed the following year.

THE WAR ON THE MOOR

The 'War on the Moor' was a football match played between Fryup FC and Fryup Athletic in 1982. Due to an ongoing feud, the manager of Fryup FC, Jed Sprule, refused to select any members of the Siskin family. The Siskins responded by setting up their own team, which joined the Moor League for the start of the 1982 season. Their first meeting was abandoned after ten minutes due to fighting between rival players and supporters. Three players and two supporters required hospital treatment. Such was the extent of the violence that both teams were immediately banned from the league and had their records expunged. Both managers and six players were issued with sine die banning orders. Two years later, a new team, the current Fryup United, was formed.

HERMITS

There was an old woman who lived in a small stone shack amid the wilderness of the Fryup coal holes, a place rendered almost impenetrable through summer by the sky-high bracken, and in winter by its treacherous, snow-filled ravines. No-one knew the woman's name, only that she had lived there for all of her ninety-nine years, without electricity or running water. Seldom in all those years had she left the high moors to venture even as far as Fryup itself. Once, when a prospective documentary maker battled his way through the boulders and bracken to find her, he was warned off by the rabid barking of the woman's dogs, and the sight of a 12-bore shotgun sticking out of one of the shack's small windows.

PURPLE WAVE III

BORSTAL BITCHES v MERMAIDS (2001)

A sexploitation spin-off from 1999's *Escape From Cold Blow, Borstal Bitches.*. finds the remaining escapees fashioning an audacious plan to reprise an old folk tale and pretend to be mermaids in order to slip unnoticed back into society, charm the local boys, and steal their loot. Their plan works perfectly until it comes to the attention of the *real* mermaids, who plot blood-spattered and suitably saucy revenge on the imposters.



RACKETS

The Fryup Classic was a lawn tennis tournament staged by Fryup Rackets Club for four years in the early 1980s, attracting international stars including Vitas Gerulaitis and Bettina Bunge. In 1988, the club's application for expansion sparked local protests, culminating in the courts being attacked by members of Fryup Liberation Front, who poured the initials 'FLF' across them using petrol, and set them ablaze.

YACKERS

Yackers was a 1990 film produced by members of Fryup Young Farmers' Club in response to a BBC Schools commission for a homemade documentary entitled 'Life On The Farm'. The film, which was leaked to newspapers, was accused of "ploughing through a wild, rural world of sex, drink and debauchery" by the Express, while The Times said it exposed "the secret face of feral Britain". Scenes included pig-swill wrestling, badger-baiting, and a drunken hay-barn orgy. Its protagonists later revealed that the scenes in the film had been faked - and the media storm concocted - in order to expose and subvert the lazy stereotypes with which young farmers were routinely confronted.

BRIDE-DUCKING

Bride-ducking was still prevalent in Fryup hardly more than half a century ago. On Boxing Day, from dawn till dusk, a suitor would seek to kidnap the object of his affection and transport them over five miles of rugged moorland to the beach to be "ducked", whereupon it would be acknowledged that a marital commitment had been achieved, irrespective of the true feelings of the sodden "bride". However, such a mission was fraught with risk, for the girls' relatives would stop at nothing to prevent her submersion into matrimony, which would be seen to have brought shame upon them. They would give chase with gusto, and threats and violence were not uncommon. Brothers of particularly sought-after girls would often keep them under lock and key for the duration of the day in question, especially if, as was true in some cases, they were suspected of plotting with an illicit lover to submit. successful "ducking" would earn the perpetrator his permanent reward, so a failure would lead to painful repercussions, for example a spell in the village stocks, tarring-and-feathering, or even in the failed groom being driven out of the dale for good.

LUCKY HO

Lucky Ho is the longest-running Chinese takeaway in the North Riding. Menu items include Ho Chop Suey and Special Ho Mein. Rumours abound over what makes the Ho Mein special. Its proprietor, known as Chinese Julie, is a 6-dan kendo champion who keeps a bamboo sword behind the counter to fend off drunks.



ROXBY

The picturesque ruins of Roxby castle belie such a gruesome history of murder, rape, incest, infanticide, adultery, torture, treachery, treason, extortion, betrayal, abduction, arson, gluttony, burglary, buggery, sodomy, blackmail, perjury, perversion, battery, roguery, piracy, heresy, larceny, ursury and witchcraft, that it is a wonder there are any stones still standing at all.

GOOSEGANG

The further you got down Goosegang Lane, the more likely you were to find errant items of underwear wedged in hedges, or scruffy old men in long raincoats loitering with no particular intent. Maybe there was something about its bramble-spiked borders and dark, fly-tipped dells that cultivated residents of a certain repute. Whitney Spears lived with her folks and an unhinged half-sister in the old railway cottage slap-bang at the bottom, just before the lane petered out into the full-blown wild.



COCO


Coco Golightly is a former plus-size burlesque dancer from Fryup, who also performed as her alter-ego Ingrid the German Games Mistress. She featured as the latter in the Purple Wave movie *Coal Hole Hostage*, and also recorded a scene for the Kola Kubes movie *Sweet Tooth*, in which, playing herself, she confessed to being a white witch. The scene was deleted from the final cut, but is still available on extended and bootleg versions. Golightly appeared as a character in the Fryup Championship Wrestling (FCW), as Ingrid, the sadistic manager of tag team champions The Bombshells. She also wrestled Ken Tucky in a Super-Sized Battle of the Sexes, which she lost after interference by The Camo Girls.

OLGA

Olga Siskin is a former figure skater from Fryup, North Yorkshire. Siskin won the British title in 1985, but was disqualified midway through the European Championships in Copenhagen the following year, after skating a routine to Sigue Sigue Sputnik's 'Love Missile F1-11' that featured a number of illegal moves. Siskin, who always performed in a trademark plain black dress, had a long-standing rivalry with another Fryup figure skater, Lulu Sprule. After falling multiple times during the 1988 Olympic trials, Sprule accused Siskin of practising witchcraft against her.

LIONS

The Lions of Fryup is the nickname given to the Fryup football team that reached the first round of the FA Cup in 1979. The nickname evolved from a local newspaper report that said they "fought like lions". Fryup won six matches to become the lowest ranked team ever to reach the first round proper. They were drawn at home to Third Division Millwall, shocking the visitors by racing into a 3-0 lead at the Fryup Showgrounds, before Millwall hit back to force a 3-3 draw. In the replay at The Den, Fryup took the lead after just fourteen seconds but were eventually beaten 7-1.



MOTO GUZZI

Among thousands of Polaroids and negatives discovered in Presley's hideout were numerous shots of a teenage girl wearing a red motorcycle jacket. The girl was almost always photographed in a forest setting, usually in some degree of undress, and often with her face obscured. The identity of the girl has never been established, although many believe her to be Pearl Siskin, a local runaway. A posthumous exhibition of the photographs and other examples of Presley's work at the Fryup Institute of Conceptual Art (FICA) in 2006 was entitled *The Moto Guzzi Girl*.

GUTBALL

Gutball is a team sport in which two teams of five players pass a ball using their hands with the aim of throwing it into the goal of the opposing team. It is similar to handball, but is played with a smaller ball that is not allowed to touch the ground. Players control the ball using a single protective glove which is decorated in their team's colours. Full body contact is permitted, and injuries are frequent. Gutball is purported to be the fastest ball sport in the world.

Gutball is played almost exclusively in the North Riding. Early forms of the sport were played amongst farmers in the region, using sheep folds or farmyards as pitches, and balls made of animal intestines. The modern version of the game is played on grass or mud pitches, using hard rubber balls. The North Riding Gutball League currently comprises six teams, of which the top two contest the Vanadis Cup final each St Mark's Day. The 1988 final was featured extensively on Channel 4's *Trans World Sport*. The reigning league champions are the Fryup Black Hands.

F!TV

Fryup Independent Television (F!TV) was a short-lived cable television channel that broadcast between 1995 and 1997. F!TV was initially known for its low-budget documentary series *Fryup True Stories*, and a fourteen-episode rural soap opera, *Silver Fox Farm*. The channel subsequently became notorious for programmes such as *Kola's Frisky Freaks*, *International Farmyard Wrestling*, and news bulletins presented by Leopard Girl, a bikini-clad model whose identity was hidden beneath a fluffy, outsized leopard's head.

FREEDOM

The Fryup Freedom Party (FFP) is a regionalist political party that advocates independence for the Fryup region. Its policies include the re-habitation of the Fryup Islands, and compulsory teaching of the Fryoese language up to the age of sixteen. The Fryup Freedom Party won its first and only parliamentary seat in the Fryup and Roxby constituency in 1997, when Hilda Sprule overturned a 22,000 majority of long-time Conservative incumbent Peregrine Thorsby, However, Sprule did not take up her place in parliament, as she refused to swear an oath to the Queen.

RÀN

Ràn - named for the Norse goddess of the sea - was a pop-up restaurant established by chef Odin Sprule on the remote Fryup island of Vanadis. Promising "a contemporary take on traditional Fryoese cuisine", its fourteen-course, £400-per-head tasting menu included popcorn kittiwake, shag phaal, and the infamous Vanadis Pudding, a dessert made from sheep's blood and guano. Guests were required to endure a torrid two-hour boat trip via private charter in order to reach the restaurant: Ràn closed for good after a six-month, sold-out run.

GOOSEGANG II

The Girls of Goosegang Lane is a novel by the prolific Fryup author Ingrid Sprule. The plot centres on a semi-feral band of girls - Suzy, Sam, Debee and Tara - who contrive scandalous schemes to fend off their rivals, the notorious Garth End Girls. The Girls of Goosegang Lane was largely ignored until its re-release in 2002; whereupon it was derided as "misanthropic smut" by The Daily Telegraph.

OMELETTE

Omelette Sprule is an omelette named after the late Fryup playwright Falcon Sprule, comprising eggs, double cream, smoked brown trout, local Killer Bee chillies and Wrigley's Spearmint Gum, and finished under a grill. It was first served for Sprule at the Fryup Hall Hotel in 1986, and has remained on the menu there ever since. Variations and adaptations of *Omelette Sprule* are now served globally.





FRYUP AIR

Fryup Air was an airline established in 1996 by a consortium headed by the Fryup-born entrepreneur Dirk Thorsby. It operated charter flights between Fryup Aerodrome and a small number of European destinations, using a small fleet of Tupolev T24 aircraft. Fryup Air ceased operations in 2000, shortly after the hijacking of flight FRY014 from La Rochelle to Fryup.

Fryup Air was criticised for a racy advertising campaign, Fly High Sizzle, and gimmicks including scantily-clad stewardesses and onboard beauty contests, whose prizes included trips to the cockpit. The airline was heavily censured by aviation authorities for operating an infamous 'foam flight' to Marbella in 1999, during which a number of foam cannons were activated. The following year, Fryup Air became the first UK airline to be banned for failing to meet EU regulatory oversight standards.

Students brandishing water pistols hijacked Fryup Air flight FR014 from La Rochelle to Fryup in October 2000, demanding the captain fly them to the Chadian capital, N'Djamena. After a brief refuelling stop in Algiers, during which all other passengers were released, the plane continued to its destination, where the students spent three days in the presidential palace as guests of Chadian president Idriss Deby. Airline officials and the Chadian authorities were accused of complicity in the hijacking. The group's leader, April Sprule, called it "a prank that went too far."

FRYUP FORCE

Comprising a single drop of 100 feet from a rocky overhang, Fryup Force is England's highest unbroken waterfall. Over the years it has been crossed by tightrope walkers, jumped by stunt bikers, and used as a setting for numerous films, including the 1986 Purple Wave classic, Killer Mermaids. Fryup Force is the site of an annual competitive eating contest, the FFC Omelette-a-Rama. The plunge pool at the foot of the falls is said to contain Britain's biggest pike, nicknamed Big Bob, which is estimated to weigh over 50lb, and has eluded anglers for almost two decades.

PIKEBURGER

Pikeburger is a fast food restaurant in Fryup that specialises in burgers made from local freshwater fish, including its trademark Pikeburger, the Troutburger and the Carpburger. It achieved notoriety for the Grogburger, which comprises a patty made from the local delicacy, Grogfish. Etymologically derived from a blend of the Norse *gröf* (grave) and the Old English word for pike, *ged*, Grogfish is fermented pike that has been buried for over 100 days then hung for four to six months. Its ammonia-like smell is so extreme that the Grogburger can only be prepared and served outdoors. Numerous celebrity chefs have beaten a path to Fryup to try it: Anthony Bourdain described the Grogburger as the worst thing he had ever eaten.



KOLA II

In 1997 she accepted an offer of £100,000 to burst out of a birthday cake for the brother of the Sultan of Brunei. During her one-month stay in the country, she claimed to have been held hostage in a harem.

In 1998, she incurred the wrath of the Animal Liberation Front when she wore a baby seal bikini to the American premiere of 'Sweet Tooth' in Seattle. Two days later, at a show in Portland, she was splashed with fish guts by protesters.

In 2000, for her marriage to the Miami Dolphins linebacker Bobby Schultz in Las Vegas, she flew out the staff of Fryup Fisheries along with two hundred frozen cod portions, six sacks of potatoes, and three vats of pre-made mushy peas. Tabloids dubbed the wedding reception "Kola's fifty-grand fish supper".

In 2002, she announced her intention to adopt two children from Chad. Her subsequent, high-profile trip to the Chadian capital, N'Djamena, incurred the wrath of the authorities and she was briefly detained in the notorious Koro Toro high security prison before being deported.

PIRATES

Fryup Pirates were a short-lived rugby league team that played in the third division of the Stones Bitter Championship for two seasons from 1996 to 1998. During their brief existence they failed to win a single match, and suffered a record 148-0 defeat to Hull Kingston Rovers in December 1997. In 1998 club owner Dirk Thorsby announced the club had signed a sponsorship deal with the adult cable network Television X, and changed its name to the TVX Pirates. Plans included a hot pink strip and an X-rated cheerleading squad. When rugby league officials rejected the deal, the club was wound up.

DEPTFORD

The Deptford Tavern, commonly known as The Deptford, is the oldest public house in Fryup, dating back to the early 18th century. Once a notorious meeting place of smugglers and pirates, the Deptford achieved notoriety in the 1980s as the venue for early gigs by the punk rock band, *The Punk Pirates*. In 2002, The Deptford featured in a Channel Four series, *Britain's Toughest Pubs*. It has been closed on numerous occasions for licensing breaches, and in 1998 was badly damaged in an arson attack.

WOODSMOKE

Woodsmoke Sibby was a racing greyhound who won a world record 30 straight races at the Fryup Showgrounds track between 1984 and 1986, including three consecutive Fryup Derbies. Amongst her vanquished opponents were all-time greats Ballyregan Bob and Scurlogue Champ. Sibby's owner, Dickie Sprule, claimed to have acquired the dog from gypsies, who promised him untold success provided he only raced her in Fryup. Finally unable to resist the temptation to enter her for the lucrative Greyhound Derby at Wimbledon in 1987, Sibby disappeared from her kennel during transit, and was never seen again.





FRYUPS VII

The first three keepers of the Edda lighthouse, constructed in 1807 at the northernmost tip of the distant Fryup island of Mardoll, vanished without trace, their meals half finished and their oilskin capes still hanging on their pegs just inside the structure's locked main door. Suspicion immediately fell upon the islanders, whose bounty from the innumerable wrecks on the treacherous reefs surrounding the islands had been gravely threatened since the lighthouse's inauguration. But no trace of the men was ever found: subsequent keepers came armed with muskets, pistols and swords.

SONS OF FRYUP

Freyja-Sonr, translated from the Fryoese as Sons of Freyja, was a group responsible for a series of arson attacks against holiday cottages and second homes in the Fryup region between 1979 and 1990. The group was supported by significant elements of local public opinion, which blamed second home-owners for driving up prices and ruining fragile local economies. Despite a series of large-scale police investigations, the perpetrators remained unpunished. In 1990, Fryup's long-serving member of parliament, Peregrine Thorsby, was targeted with a letter bomb, which failed to detonate.

FRYUPS VIII

A tall, striking figure, with a bristling moustache, Gilbert Thorsby was a self-styled dandy and adventurer who published luridly detailed accounts of trips to Africa and the South Seas - *Among the Blacks* and *To the Tropics* - which were later exposed as elaborate fakes. Chastened, Thorsby disclaimed his family fortune in favour of leading an hermetic life on the remote Fryup island of Vanadis. His subsequent, unfinished manuscript, *With the Fryoese*, chronicling the lives and customs of the islanders in the early decades of the 20th century, is regarded as the seminal work on the subject.




KOLABURGER III

Kolaburger released its first plant-based burger, the Sweet Tooth Vegan Deluxe, in 2022. The burger comprised two green-coloured, plant-based patties, topped with strips of lime Jello, vegan cheese, pickles, mint sauce, green tomato ketchup, sour apples, soor plums, and green jelly snakes. The burger was discontinued the following year, following reports that a number of consumers had turned green after eating it. Tabloid newspapers dubbed it 'The Inedible Hulk Burger'.

FRY-HIGH

Fry-High is a book, published anonymously in 2002, that purports to be an oral history of Fryup High School in the late 1980s and early 1990s. During this period the school yielded a series of famous alumni, including an adult movie actress, a champion boxer and a leading conceptual artist; hit headlines for scandals involving alien abductions and guerrilla movements; and was featured in one tabloid newspaper under the banner headline, "Is this the most debauched school in Britain?"
